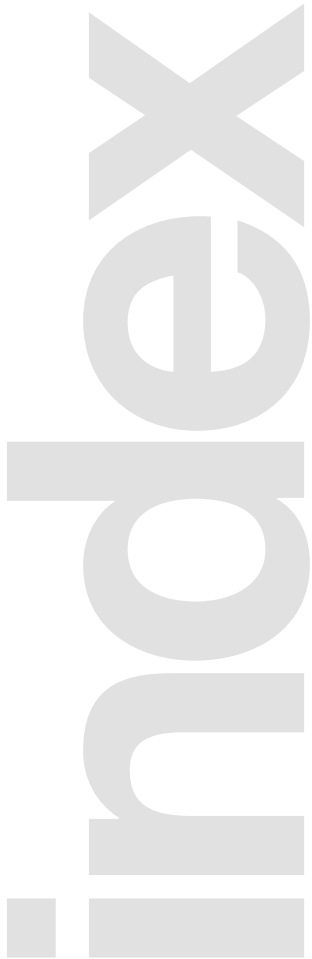

Professional Qualifications

All students who pass the final examination of the Professional Practitioner Course are entitled to use the letters '**DHP**' (Diploma in Hypnotherapy) after their name on stationery and advertising. Although this is not a government-recognised qualification, it is generally accepted the 'standard' for hypnotherapists in the UK. Some schools issue 'Dip. H.', or other similar letters, which mean the same as 'DHP'. You will occasionally see 'Master Hypnotist', 'MA', 'BA' or even 'Dr.' being used, but none are officially recognised in the UK or any other country. There are, in fact, no 'official' qualifications for Hypnotherapists anywhere in the world.

Upon successful completion of the course you will receive:

- > **DHP - Diploma in Hypnotherapy**
- > **DHA - Diploma in Hypnoanalysis**

Then you will be eligible to use the letters DHP and DHA after your name.

This means that you will be able to start up immediately with all the skills and knowledge that you need to build a successful practice!

In House students will be entitled to certification by each of the accrediting bodies, and will therefore be able to append the relevant letters to their name on all advertising and publicity and in connection with any professional endeavour. These letters reflect the grade of 'Licentiate' and are: **LHA, LNCP, LAPHP**. Currently, no reputable registering body will accept membership from individuals who have completed their studies solely by Distance Learning; this is not a bar to commencing professional practice, however, and membership of these bodies may be attained after, in most cases, two years of consulting room work.

accreditation

It is important to understand that because of the UK's legal tradition of common law, there are no formal regulations regarding the practice of Hypnotherapy. However, we feel that external validation is a very good way to assess students capability and we are working towards the NCFE accreditation and also students are encouraged to create a portfolio of work and follow learning outcomes.

Clinical Supervision

Students will be placed in Clinical Supervision at a time decided by the tutor based on progress. It is hoped that students will maintain this relationship post-diploma. The APHP will provide a list of recognised Supervisors for the student's use. Supervised practice is an integral part of the Course. Supervision allows the students to speak and get advice from a more experienced therapist, and can often be invaluable to a new therapist. During training and after the mid way exam the trainer will decide if the student is ready to work with clients and will put them under supervision. This means that students can work whilst studying the course.

Student Therapy

Like learning any therapy it is important to undertake what we call '**training therapy**'. This is done to allow the students to deal with any issues they may have, prepare them for being a therapist and prevent transference from clients. A list of therapists will be provided that are of good standing and known to the trainer.

Clients

During the training, clients will be provided for the students, to prepare themselves for going into practice. The clients will be presenting with real issues and although aware of the students status, will provide honest feedback. This again is a valuable resource only offered by this training school.

eligibility and fees

courses fees

Hypnotherapy is a profession that incorporates a significant responsibility to the public who seek our services. As such, we do not simply allow anyone who applies, to do the course. We feel that it is of the utmost importance that anyone who undertakes this course must:

- > be of suitable character to take on a career of working with vulnerable people
- > be sufficiently mature in order to be able to listen to traumatic material without being unduly affected personally
- > have sufficient background and experience to be able to meet the academic demands of the course.

All applicants will be interviewed to determine their suitability for the course.

Course Fees

Course fees may be paid by cash or cheque and this course is also eligible for a Government-sponsored Career development loan. In addition, we may be able to spread the cost over a longer period than shown below - please ask for details.

If paying by instalments, you can cancel at any time with no penalty, provided we have at least 28 days notice. If you pay in advance, we will issue a balance refund if you find the need to cancel your training for any reason; again, we require at least 28 days notice.

The total cost of the In House programme is **£2250.00** Sterling. If you wish, you can pay via ten monthly instalments of £2250.00 Sterling

All required books are included in the fee for the classroom based course ; there is nothing else to pay. In addition, our unique fee structure is such that not only can you pay by monthly instalments if you wish, you can withdraw from the course without penalty at any time, provided you give us 28 days notice. what exactly is hypnotherapy?

There are many fears and misunderstandings about the use of hypnosis and hypnotherapy, and the myths and mystery that surround it are totally undeserved. The fact of the matter is that Hypnotherapy is an astonishingly effective treatment method for a huge number of human difficulties, both psychological and physical. It is not unusual for somebody to find relief, within only two or three sessions, from a problem that may have persisted for years and may have been unresponsive to other treatments. And when used in a complementary fashion, to assist with rapid healing after surgery or for pain control, for example, the results can be truly astounding.

The Truth about Clinical Hypnosis

Stage hypnosis shows, along with television and film portrayals, often appear to show that the hypnotised person has surrendered control to the hypnotist but this is most definitely not the case. An individual in hypnosis is certainly not in any way unconscious and retains completely free will and a total awareness of themselves and everything that is happening around them at all times. There is obviously a high element of showmanship on stage and a need for drama in film and television productions, and this is part of the reason why hypnosis is sometimes portrayed as a kind of 'mystical control'.

Nothing Magical

There is nothing magical about hypnosis, it is not in any way dangerous (you cannot get 'stuck', lose your mind, or be 'possessed' in any way) and the therapy using it - hypnotherapy - has no harmful side effects. And the great thing about it is that you do not have to have some special 'gift of hypnosis' to be able to use it, because almost anybody can learn it. This means that you could soon be helping others to overcome their emotional and psychological difficulties and helping them to find a life that they had never thought possible.

Therapy using clinical hypnosis - Hypnotherapy - is a reliable technique for beneficial change which is centuries old and is recognised by many branches of conventional medicine as a valuable complementary addition to medication, to assist with healing, and to help manage pain; like all therapies, it does not work for everybody, but it can certainly do no harm. Whilst not a panacea for all ills, it is an effective drugs-free treatment method for a great many ailments where psychological factors are involved.

Will I be Registered?

Successful In House students of the Professional Practitioner Course will be eligible for provider numbers of both NHS and BUPA (BUPA after mandatory 5 years in clinical practice), meaning that clients may be referred by a doctor, medical specialist or consultant.

Will I be able to learn it?

You need have no previous experience of therapy of any sort to become a successful hypnotherapist - in fact, all our courses are written with the assumption that the student may have no more than a vague idea of what therapy actually is and is supposed to do.

You don't need to be a 'special' type of person, either; successful hypnotherapists come from such truly diverse backgrounds as shop assistants, company directors, lorry drivers, bank clerks, insurance brokers, housewives, househusbands, factory workers, police officers, computer programmers, ballroom dancers, musicians, welders, electronics engineers, builders... whatever occupation you can think of, it's almost certain that a therapist somewhere has been it.

What can I achieve?

These days, more and more people are turning towards 'natural' complementary treatments for mental, physical and emotional difficulties. Sometimes, they have a problem they have struggled to find relief from for years, without success. Other times, they just need someone to talk to, to help them through a difficult time in their lives. Still others may have a personal problem that they feel they cannot sort out on their own, but which causes too much embarrassment to discuss with family or friends, or even their doctor.

A trained therapist can be of great help with a wide variety of problems and be of great service to a huge number of people, whether working in full time practice or just part time from a home consulting room. It's not just about helping people quit smoking, though that is easy to do. It's about helping people to rediscover happiness and contentment, security and confidence. It's about helping them to get from where they are to where they want to be..

But isn't there a special gift involved?

This is a common misconception. In reality, though, literally anybody can learn to hypnotise another, and in far less time than most people might imagine - it is a simple skill and one that requires no special abilities.

What will I actually learn?

In a nutshell, you will learn everything you need to be successful: Hypnotherapy and hypnoanalysis; stress management for individuals or corporations; client management skills; setting up and maintaining a successful practice; advertising and legal requirements; how to get referrals from Doctors; how to ensure a steady flow of clients... and more.

How much can I earn?

That depends on many factors... how many hours you want to work, whether you are working from home or a consulting room, the fees you decide to set, and so on. All these eventualities are covered in detail in our tuition, since we teach you not just how to be a therapist, but how to be a successful therapist.

As a guide, though, most therapists charge somewhere between £50.00 and £70.00 for a fifty minute session (2008 prices), depending largely upon the geographical area in which they set up their consulting room. Although it might take a while to build up a full-time practice, it is certainly something which is within reach of most.

Not everybody works as a therapist in private practice, though, and those who choose to work in the commercial sector can easily earn more in a day than many people earn in a month. When you complete the Essex Institute Professional Practitioner course, you will have the necessary skills to pursue that avenue, if you wish. We can even teach you the presentation skills you would need to be outstanding in that field, too.

What other benefits are there?

To be a Hypnotherapist is also to have a career for as long as you want it, an income for life– there are no age limits – and to work either full or part-time, with the option to take time off when you need it .
